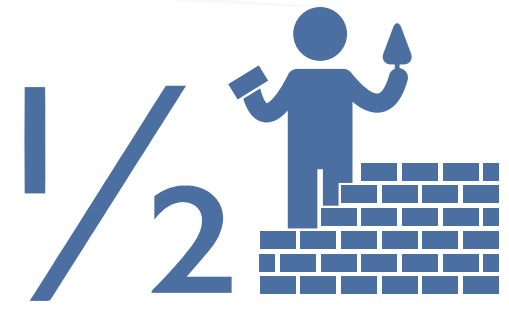

This industry covers a wide range of activities, separated into eight groups



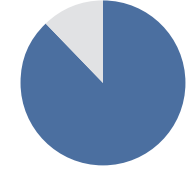

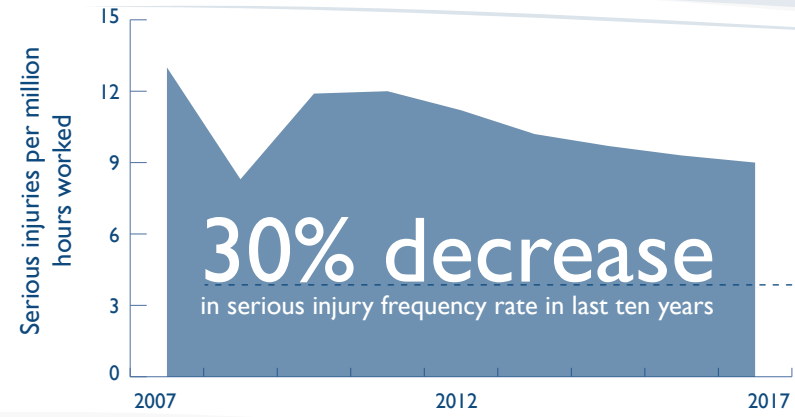

THE INJURIES

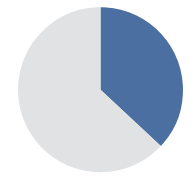
665

37% of injuries over the last ten years resulted in at least one week off work

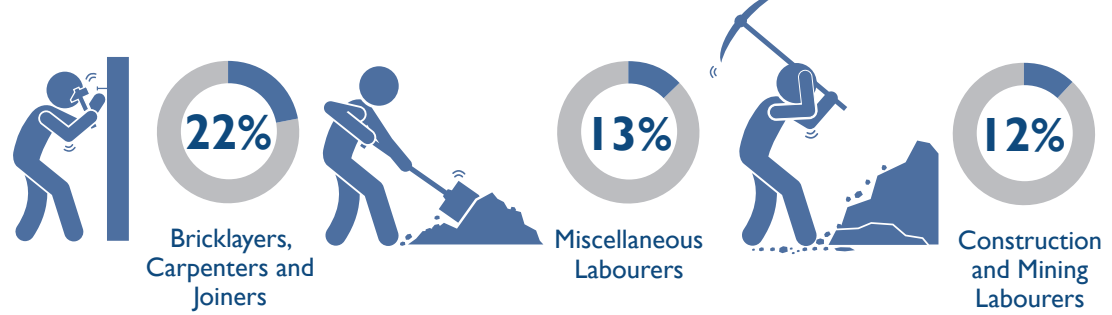
