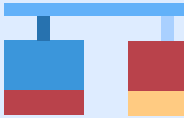

MyState Bank Arena is located centrally in Glenorchy, an easy 10 minute drive from Hobart, and has unrivalled on-site parking for over 1,200 cars. Situated right on the banks of the clear blue Derwent River with panoramic mountain and water views, MyState Bank Arena provides a calm and picturesque setting for any event.

The fascinating Glenorchy Art & Sculpture Park (GASP) follows the Derwent River shoreline around MyState Bank Arena, further enhancing the natural atmosphere of the venue with interesting modern art installations and a relaxing waterfront walk.

## About the WorkCover Tasmania Board

The WorkCover Tasmania Board works with workers, employers, medical practitioners, licensed insurers, self-insurers and others to ensure a fair and equitable workers compensation scheme, good injury management outcomes and safer workplaces for all Tasmanian workers.

To achieve this, the Board:

- Oversees Tasmania's workers compensation scheme and monitors the performance of scheme participants
- Promotes prompt and effective injury management
- Promotes safe and healthy workplaces by providing health and safety guidance.

## Relationship with WorkSafe Tasmania

The Board has a strong relationship with WorkSafe Tasmania.

WorkSafe Tasmania supports the Board and delivers the Board's priorities and programs ranging from projects to improve Tasmania's workers compensation scheme to services that provide education, advice and information on work health and safety, injury management and return to work. The delivery of these services complement other workplace regulatory functions undertaken by WorkSafe Tasmania such as the work health and safety regulation and asbestos compensation.

WorkSafe Tasmania also informs the Board of emerging national work health and safety issues, and developments in work health and safety matters in other jurisdictions.

Specific Exhibition Information	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• WorkSafe Tasmania will determine the final layout of the Expo and exhibitor stalls, displays and activities.</li><li>• The exhibitor must not extend items outside the stall space unless prior agreement has been obtained from WorkSafe Tasmania.</li><li>• The exhibitor may not display materials that may be considered offensive by WorkSafe Tasmania.</li><li>• Exhibitions must be left in a neat and tidy condition at all times.</li><li>• During the event, exhibitions must be staffed at all times.</li></ul>
Payment and Cancellations	<p>Payment may be made by credit card at time of registration or by invoice; and complete payment must be received within invoice terms.</p> <p>For packages cancelled:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• 30 days before the Expo: 50% refund</li><li>• Within 30 days of the Expo: 0% refund</li></ul>
Health and Safety	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• WorkSafe Tasmania reserves the right to decline, accept, or withdraw and refund an exhibitor at its absolute discretion. This may include, but is not limited to, situations in which the exhibitor, or a related person or organisation, has breached or is under investigation for possible breaches of work health and safety laws (whether or not a prosecution is pending), does not hold appropriate insurances, including Workers Compensation insurance, or where the acceptance of the entry may otherwise be detrimental to the objectives of WorkSafe Tasmania and the WorkSafe Expo.</li><li>• Exhibitors must comply with all relevant health and safety regulations on the event day.</li><li>• Exhibitors must agree to immediately rectify any health and safety breaches identified by WorkSafe Tasmania.</li><li>• WorkSafe Tasmania reserves the right to close the exhibitor's stall if a serious breach of health and safety is not immediately rectified.</li></ul>
Security and Risk	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Exhibitors acknowledge that whilst all care is taken, all liability for loss or damage of such property whatsoever shall be the sole risk of the exhibitor, notwithstanding that such loss or damage may have arisen through the inadvertent or negligent acts of any person, including staff and subcontractors.</li><li>• The exhibitor's property is the responsibility of the exhibitor at all times.</li></ul>
