

Application for Type 2 Fireworks Permit

This application must be submitted at a Service Tasmania Shop, at least 21 days prior to display date with the prescribed \$79.00 fee

This form is to be used by persons who are not pyrotechnicians and who wish to apply for a Type 2 fireworks display permit for the purpose of a Commonwealth Day celebration on 25 May 2019. Applicants must be at least 18 years old.

The applicant must lodge the application by 3 May 2019. Late applications will not be accepted.

A fireworks display permit may be refused if:

- the proposed fireworks display cannot be safely organised or held
- there is not sufficient time for the application to be properly considered before the date of the proposed display
- information provided in this or previous applications is false or misleading
- multiple applications have been made for the same address

A fireworks permit is unlikely to be granted where the proposed display site is:

- located in Acton Park, Allens Rivulet, Carlton, Devon Hills, Dodges Ferry, Orielson, Roches Beach or Sandford
- in close proximity to privately owned horses/livestock which might be harmed if a fireworks display was to be conducted
- within 1 kilometre of a commercial boarding kennel or commercial horse business
- within 3 kilometres of a sanctuary or conservation area, such as Bonorong Wildlife Sanctuary, Tasmania Zoo, and Trowunna Wildlife Park (Applicants intending to hold a fireworks display in these areas should seek alternative locations.)

If issued with a fireworks display permit, you must:

Notify adjoining property owners at least 7 days prior to the display, and strictly comply with the display date, times and permit conditions.
